# Construction Update

The Sunshine Hospitality Home is in the construction phase thanks to all of the hard work from everyone involved in this project and from the generosity of each of our donors.

As of this writing, excavation and site work have mostly been completed. The foundations of the building have been built. Underground plumbing, electrical, and all other underground utilities have also been installed.

None of this would be possible without the hard work from Community Contractors, Ae2S Surveying crew, Teraacon Consultants, Florian & Sons Excavating, Inc., A & S Construction, Strata Corporation, M&K Porta Potties, Schmidts Excavating, Opp Construction, Lunseth Plumbing & Heating Co., RBB Electric, Rhino Contracting, Inc., Countrywide Sanitation, and Molstad Excavating Inc. Many have donated all or a portion of their services.

The next steps are framing, rough grading, parking lot work, and then enclosure.

Currently, we have approximately \$400,000 left to raise. This number includes the money needed to purchase furniture, fixtures, and equipment for the Home.
